SPEAKER'S BIOGRAPHY

Hendrik Scholl is one of the two founding directors of the Institute of Molecular and Clinical Ophthalmology Basel (IOB). He is also Professor and Chairman of the Department of Ophthalmology, University of Basel, Switzerland. He specializes in the treatment of retinal diseases, specifically inherited retinal and macular dystrophies, and in research on retinal neurodegeneration.

In 2016, Prof. Scholl joined the University Basel as Professor and Chairman of the Department of Ophthalmology. Prof. Scholl has authored over 250 articles and reviews in peer-reviewed journals and received numerous prestigious awards, including the European Vision Award, the President's Award of the American Society of Retinal Specialists, the W. Richard Green Award and the Paul Henkind Memorial Award of the Macula Society, and the Swiss Alfred-Vogt Award.

Prof. Scholl participates and/or chairs several Data Monitoring Committees of large clinical trials and has further leadership roles in ophthalmology such as the president of the European Vision Institute (EVI) since 2016 and the Chairman of the European Vision Clinical Research Network (EVICR.net) since 2017.
